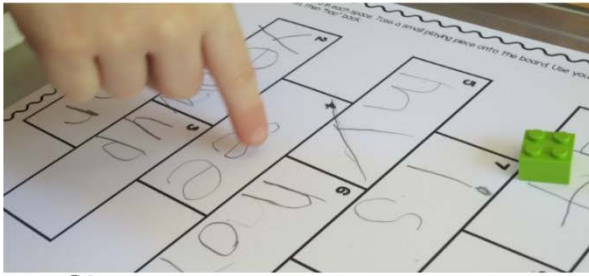
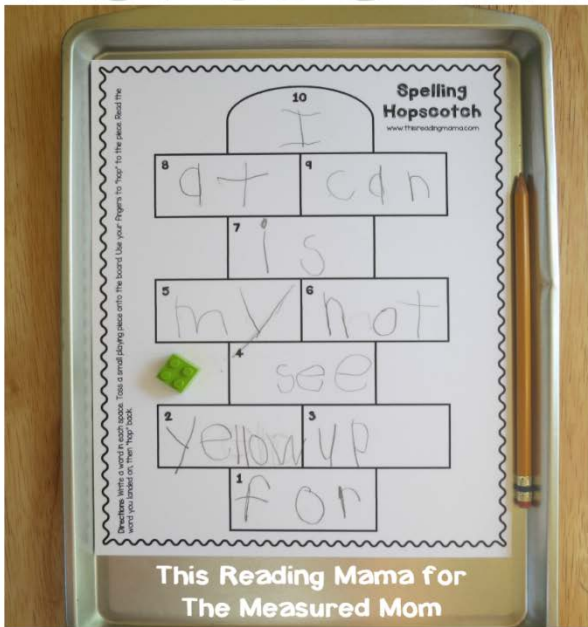


Finger Spelling Hopscotch

SPELLING HOPSCOTCH

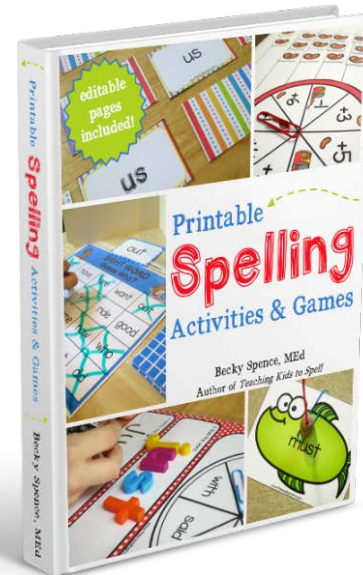


To Prep:

- Print hopscotch board of choice.
- Students write 10 different sight words OR phonics words on the spelling hopscotch board.

To Play:

- The student tosses a small manipulative on the hopscotch board.
- Then the student uses his/her fingers to "hop" to the word the manipulative landed on, reads the word and does it again.
- Optional: Students can also keep a tally mark record of which words the manipulative lands on.

Spelling Hopscotch

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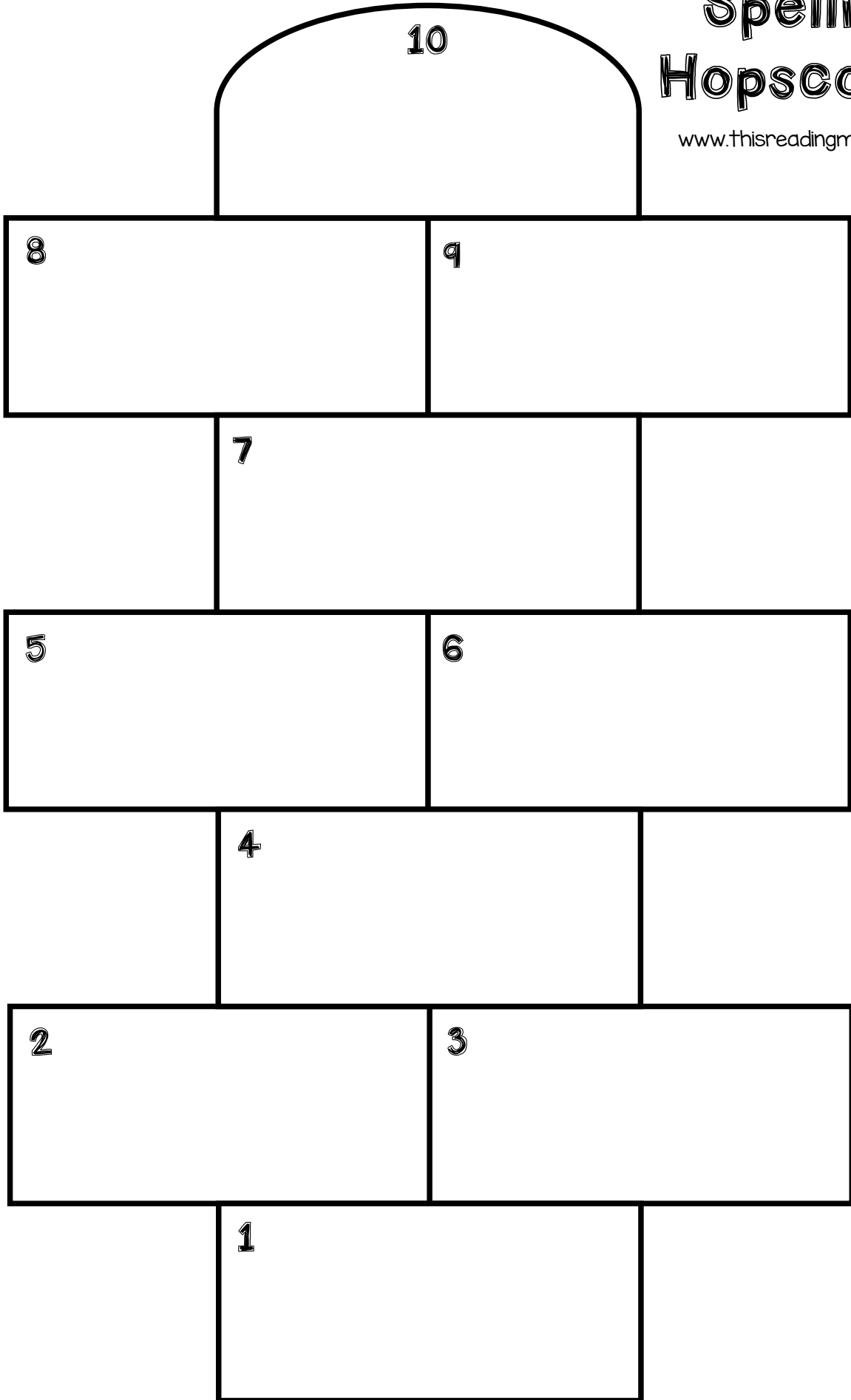
The hopscotch board consists of 10 numbered squares arranged in a standard pattern:

- 1: A single square at the bottom.
- 2 and 3: Two squares side-by-side above square 1.
- 4: A single square above squares 2 and 3.
- 5 and 6: Two squares side-by-side above square 4.
- 7: A single square above squares 5 and 6.
- 8 and 9: Two squares side-by-side above square 7.
- 10: A square at the top, enclosed in a semi-circular arch, above squares 8 and 9.

Directions: Write a word in each space. Toss a small playing piece onto the board. Use your fingers to "hop" to the piece. Read the word you landed on, then "hop" back. Try it again!

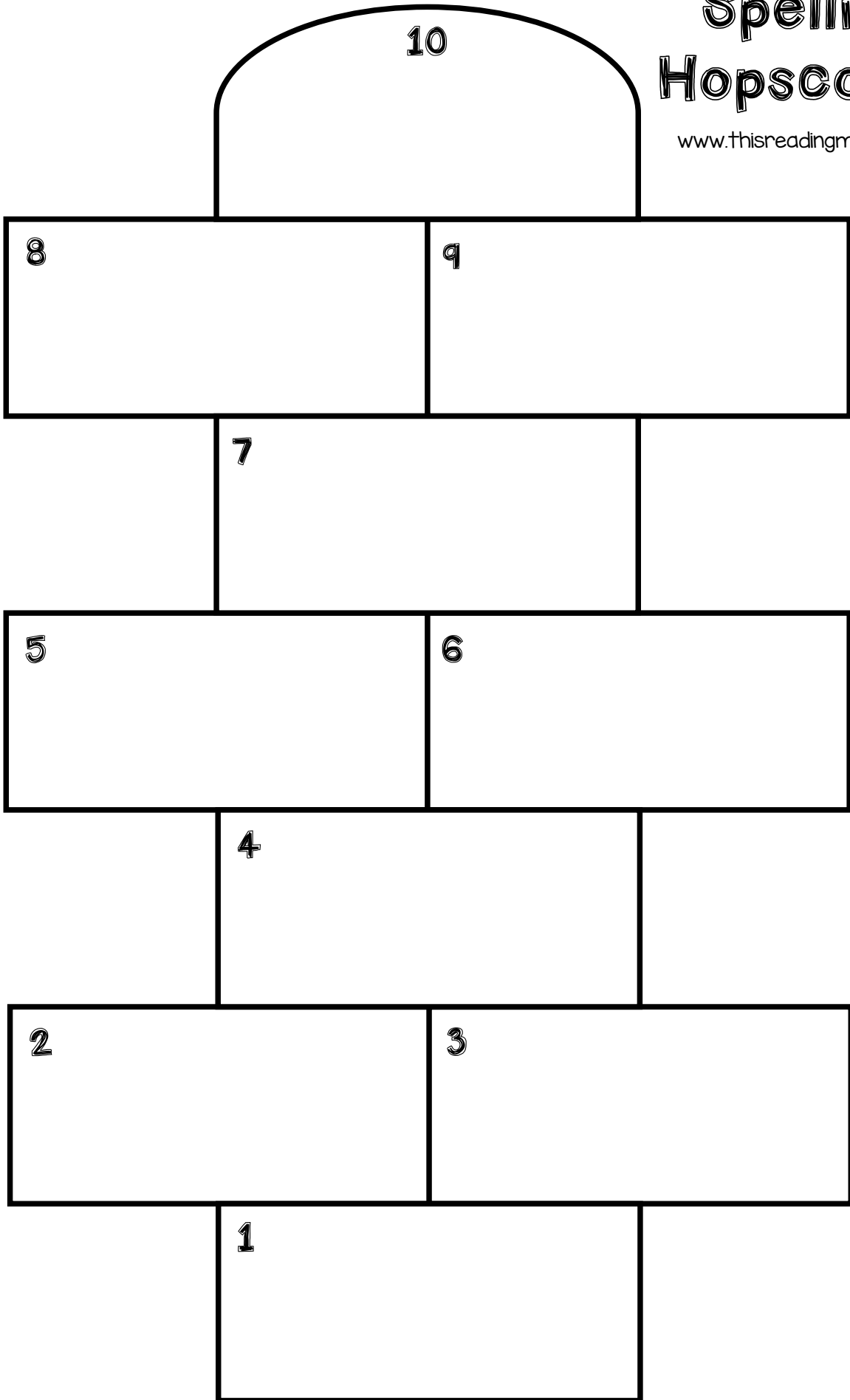

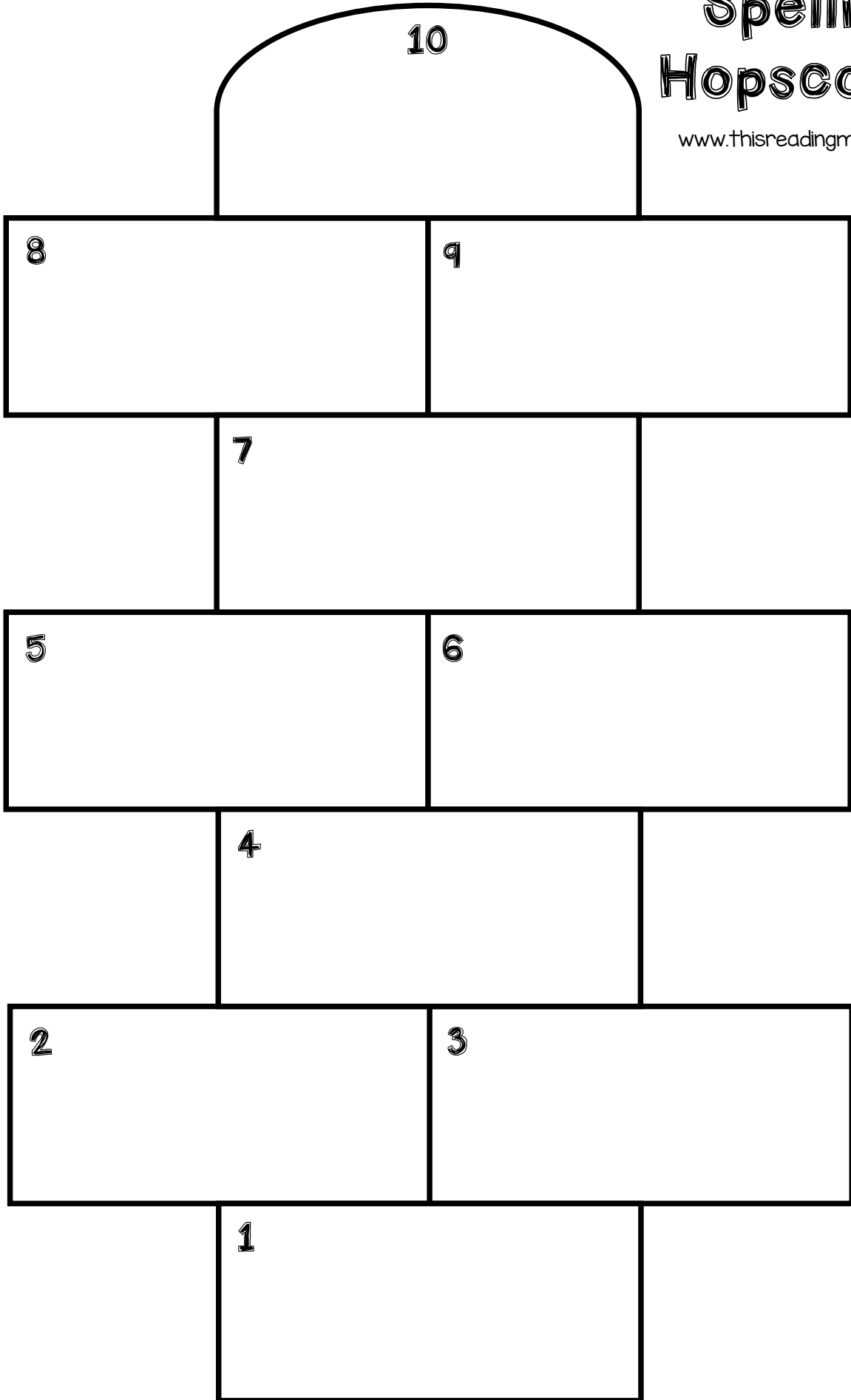

Spelling Hopscotch

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The hopscotch board consists of 10 numbered squares arranged in a standard hopscotch pattern. The squares are numbered 1 through 10, starting from the bottom and moving upwards. Squares 2 and 3 are side-by-side, as are squares 5 and 6. Squares 7 and 8 are side-by-side, as are squares 9 and 10. Square 10 is at the top and has a semi-circular arch over it. Squares 1, 3, 5, 7, and 9 are single squares, while squares 2, 4, 6, 8, and 10 are double squares.
